We will be giving every child a tube of Smarties, or an alternative if your child cannot eat Smarties, to enjoy over the Easter holidays. All we ask is for you to return the tubes, after the Easter holiday, full of 20p pieces (they fit perfectly into the tube) which they can earn for every task or helping hand exercise that they complete. We will quarantine the money for a minimum of 72 hours and then disinfect it before counting it to ensure we are Covid safe. The class that raises the most money for school will be awarded the 'Silver Smarties Fundraising Award'.
