Music Evening

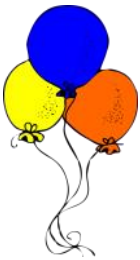
Well done to all the children who took part in the Music Evening on Tuesday. The standard of singing and playing of instruments was amazing and many positive comments have been passed on to school.

Your generous and valuable contributions are essential in enabling us to arrange the class trips and we are very grateful for your support.

Unfortunately, school no longer has the funds to subsidise trips, which means that if we do not receive enough contributions towards the cost of your child's class trip we may have no option but to cancel it. We are requesting that all contributions are paid a month in advance of the trips taking place so that we can pay both the venue and coach company, this is why we have provided advance notice of the trips.

This year we have given parents and carers the option of contributing towards the cost of their child's school trip in one full contribution or weekly/monthly installments towards the total cost. Both options are available on School Hub. Please can we ask that, if you have not already done so, you make your contribution within a month of the trip taking place.

As the cost of school trips is calculated on the number of children in a class unfortunately we are unable to refund any money paid for trips if children are unable to attend for any reason.

What is the Nurturing Programme?

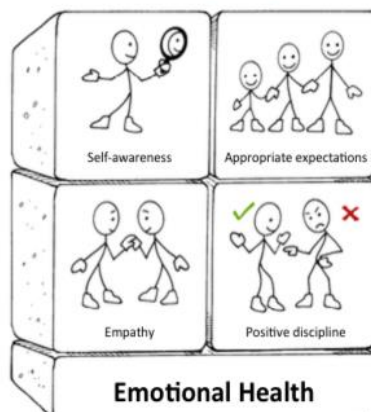
Children are rewarding, stimulating and fun, but looking after them can be stressful and challenging.

The Nurturing Programme helps deal with those challenges so that you can have a calmer, happier life.

A tried and tested programme, it helps us think about what we do, why we do it and how it makes us feel.



The Four Constructs of the Nurturing Programme

What does it cover?

Over the 10-week Programme, you will look at lots of different topics, including:

Understanding

why children behave as they do

Recognising the feelings behind behaviour (ours and theirs)

Exploring

different approaches to discipline

Finding

ways to develop co-operation and self-discipline in children

Learning the importance of looking after ourselves

How Nurturing Programme Parent Groups have helped other parents
