Arrangements for the partial closure of St. Luke's Church of England Primary School

School will re-open tomorrow morning for vulnerable and 'Key Worker' children. If you have not received a text or email to confirm that your child has been allocated a place please do not bring them to school.

For the time being, in the absence of updated Government Guidance, arrangements will remain the same as they were last term:

- Staggered start and finish times for each year group will remain the same http://www.saintlukes.wigan.sch.uk/serve_file/751645
- You can continue to order school meals via Lunch Shop and children will eat their meals within their classroom 'bubble'.
- Children should come to school in full school uniform, except on the days that they have PE when they should wear their PE Kits.
- Only one adult per household or childcare support bubble can accompany their child/children on the school yard.
- There will be no access to the main entrance to school and it will not be possible for you to drop anything off at the office unless you are requested to do so by a member of school staff
- Children should not bring a school bag. The only thing brought in to school should be a packed lunch where appropriate and appropriate outdoor clothing which reflects the current weather.
- Children must attend for a full day. We kindly ask that you do not make arrangements for appointments during the school day. If this is unavoidable we ask that you do not send them to school on that day.
- If you do not require a full week, please email school, in advance, to confirm the days that you require.
- If you no longer require your place please contact school as soon as possible.
- If you find that you are able to make alternative and safe childcare arrangements, we encourage you to do so.

As soon as we receive the anticipated updated Government Guidance I will contact you about any necessary changes. Please understand that any changes necessary will be because the guidance has changed, but as always our aim is to keep the school safely open.
